## **RESPONSE TO COVID-19**

**MELBOURNE: Crown Resorts Limited (ASX: CWN) (Crown)** announced today that, following consultation with the Victorian Government, Crown has implemented a policy covering a number of social distancing measures at its Crown Melbourne entertainment complex. With effect from today, in response to the novel coronavirus (Covid-19) pandemic, measures including the following will be implemented at Crown Melbourne:

- deactivation of every second gaming machine and electronic table game;
- distancing at seated table games between players, including no standing players;
- restricting the number of players at each stand-up table game to five players; and
- restricting the number of patrons in individual food & beverage, banqueting and conference facilities to 450 persons with a prescribed maximum density.

The social distancing policy for Crown Melbourne has been approved by the Victorian Chief Health Officer.

Crown has also implemented other precautionary measures across its Crown Melbourne and Crown Perth entertainment complexes, including the provision of alcohol-based hand sanitiser and more frequent and strengthened cleaning measures.

Crown will continue to closely monitor the pandemic and follow guidelines from relevant health authorities.
