



LUNAR NEW YEAR CELEBRATIONS KICK OFF ACROSS CROWN SYDNEY

Crown launched the initiative in partnership with Hennessy at a black-tie cocktail party in the Pearl Ballroom featuring some of Australia's most exciting new entertainers, *Crazy Rich Asians* actor Chris Pang, Peter Thurnwald from XO, *Kitty* and *It's Our Time*, and actress Ana Thu from the TV series *One Night* and the film *Mortal Kombat II* later this year.
